THANK YOU to all of our donors, worksites (and their great coordinators!), member agencies, and volunteers. YOU ARE MAKING A DIFFERENCE!

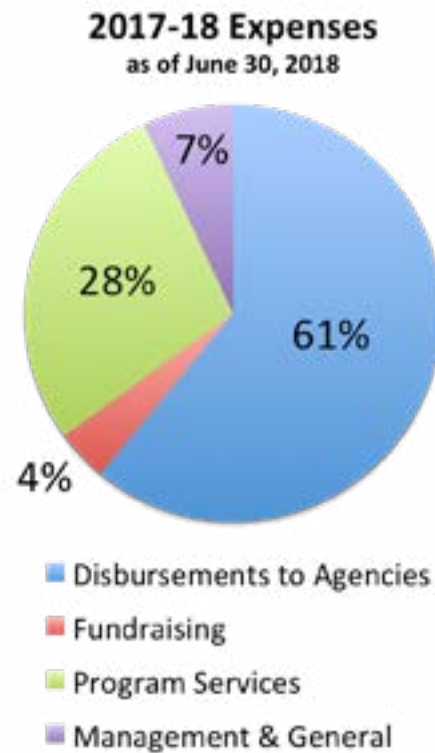
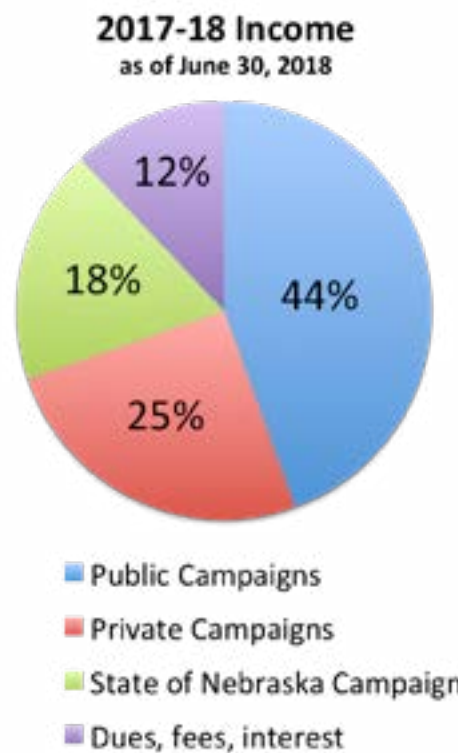
